The Somali Communication Workers Union (SOCOWU) strongly condemns the recent unjust actions committed against its dedicated members within Hormuud Telecom Somalia. Our members, hardworking individuals contributing to the nation's connectivity, have endured unwarranted suffering due to an unfortunate incident.

It is disheartening to note that the National Intelligence and Security Agency, entrusted with safeguarding the lives and dignity of Somali citizens, has been implicated in harassing SOCOWU members.
